COLLEGE STUDENT

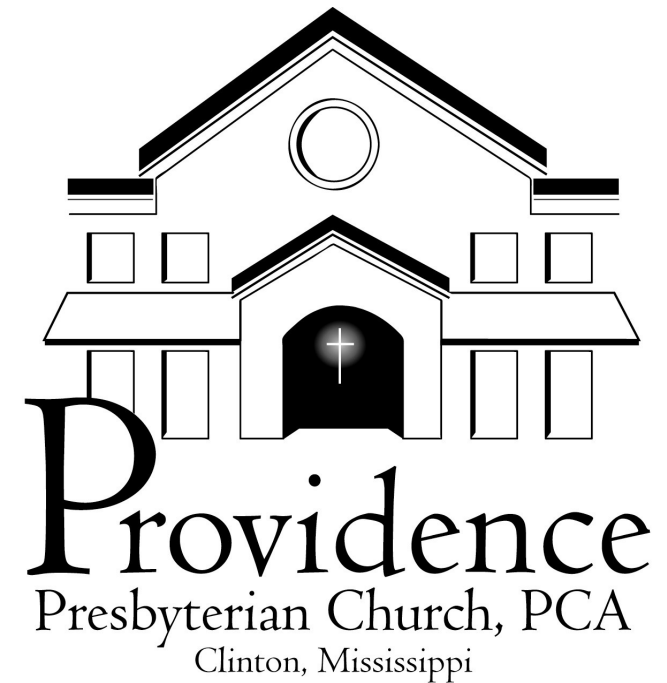
