#### FALL ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

1. "Bible 101 Survey" – taught by John Spears in the church parlor. This class will provide an overview of the Bible and was designed with visitors and new converts in mind.

2. "Psalms" – taught by Brian Gault in Adult 2 Classroom. When David longed for God's presence, he deployed the metaphor of "thirst" to express his longing. When David was heatbroken, he used poetry to capture the depth of his pain. That poetry was then given to the people of God to shape our worship. In this class we will explore how to read Hebrew poetry, investigate the types of Psalms and think about how they were put together in a book. This study will allow the Psalms to become a voice that will carry your emotions to God and a friend that carries you to Jesus.

3. "MacGyver Apologetics" – taught by Don Malin. Whenever MacGyver got into a fix, he used simple things around him to save himself and others with him. We'll learn to do the same through DVDs, role playing, and discussion.

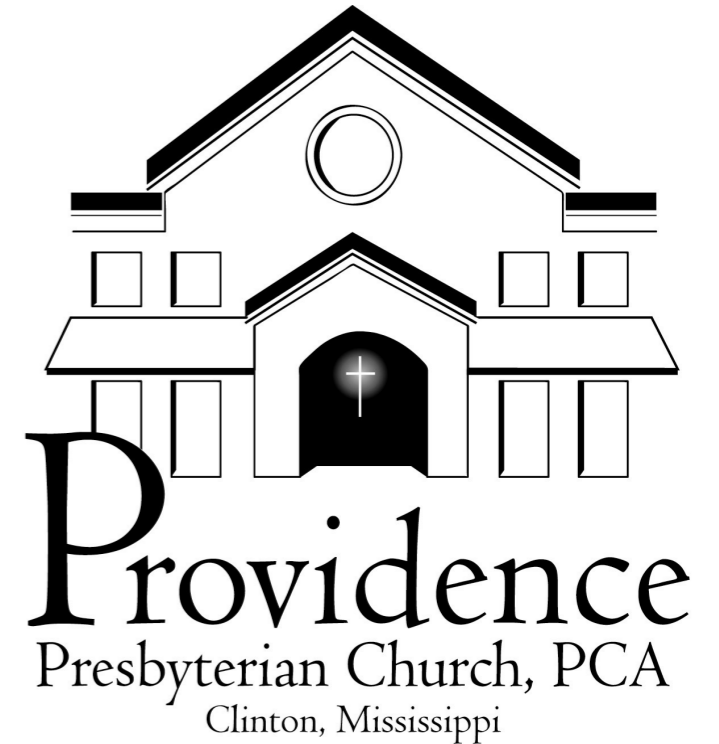
