O let me not my trust betray, but press to realms on high.

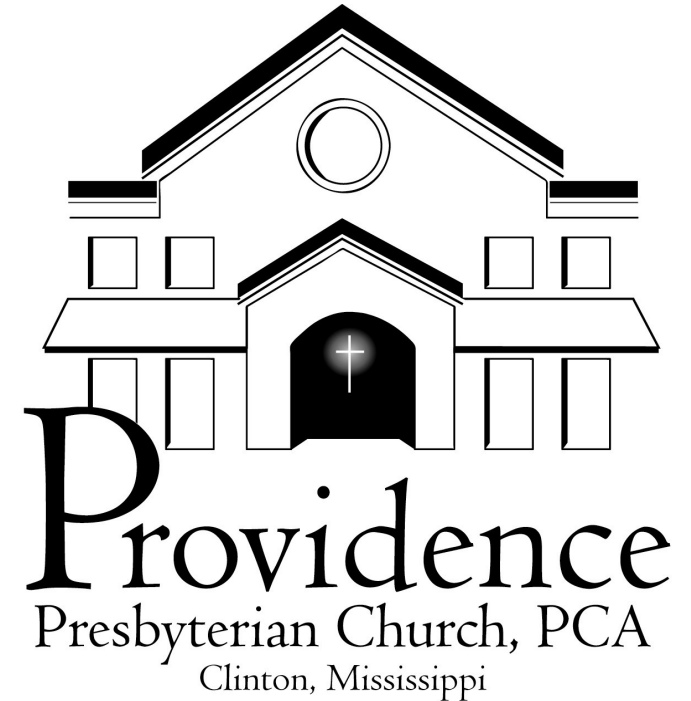
