## Heidelberg Catechism

We have been looking at the Heidelberg Catechism together on Sunday nights for the past year. This catechism was written in 1563 and is the most widely used catechism from the Reformation. It is divided into 52 "Lord's Day" sections, structured after the Book of Romans and can be outlined with three words: Guilt (#3-11), Grace (#12-85) and Gratitude (#86-129).

### Lord's Day 48

#### **Q123. What does the second petition mean?**

A. "Your kingdom come" means: Rule us by your Word and Spirit in such a way that more and more we submit to you. Preserve your church and make it grow. Destroy the devil's work; destroy every force which revolts against you and every conspiracy against your holy Word. Do this until your kingdom fully comes, when you will be all in all.

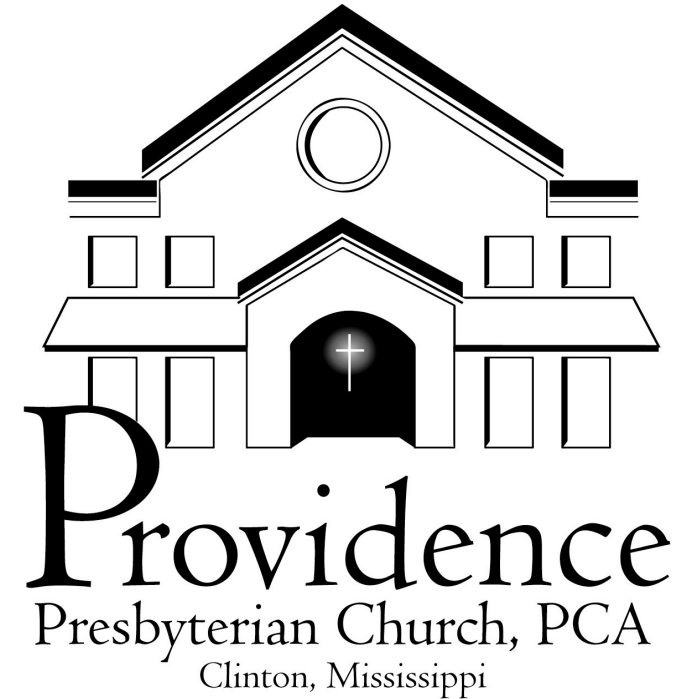
We will glorify the King of kings, we will glorify the Lamb;
