Heidelberg Catechism

We have been looking at the Heidelberg Catechism together on Sunday nights for the past year. This catechism was written in 1563 and is the most widely used catechism from the Reformation. It is divided into 52 "Lord's Day" sections, structured after the Book of Romans and can be outlined with three words: Guilt (#3-11), Grace (#12-85) and Gratitude (#86-129).

Lord's Day 49

Q124. What does the third petition mean?

A. "Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" means:

Help us and all people to reject our own wills and to obey your will without any back talk. Your will alone is good. Help us one and all to carry out the work we are called to, as willingly and faithfully as the angels in heaven.

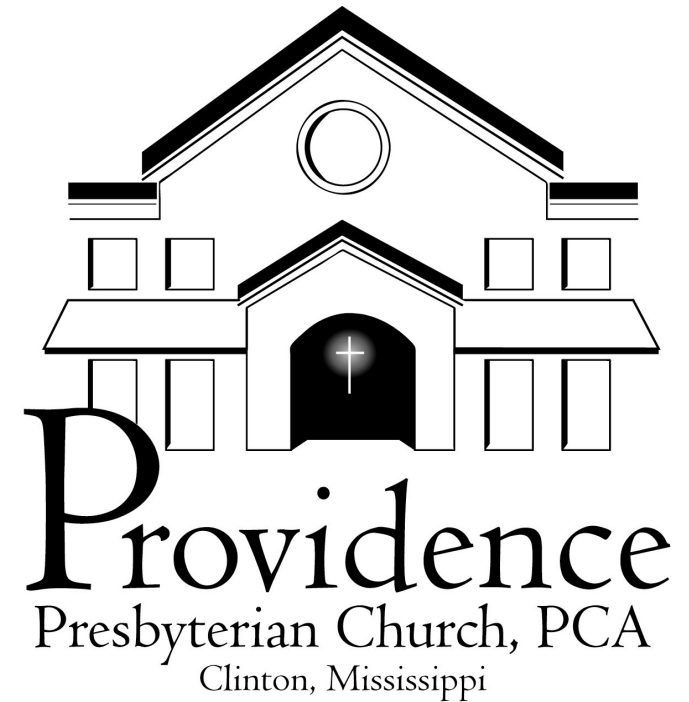
