My soul is satisfied in Him alone.

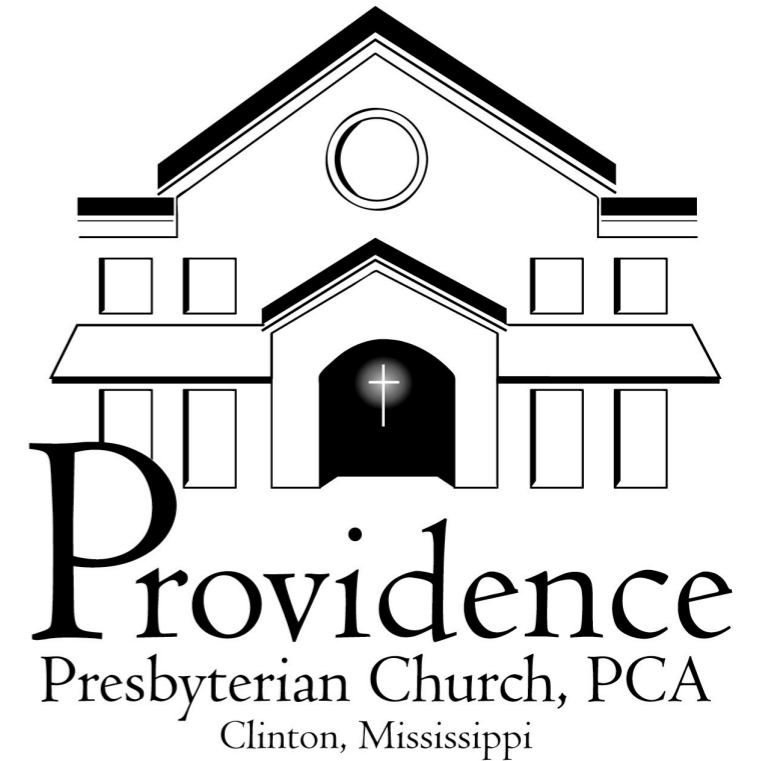
As summer flowers we fade and die
