That we may know the risen Christ.

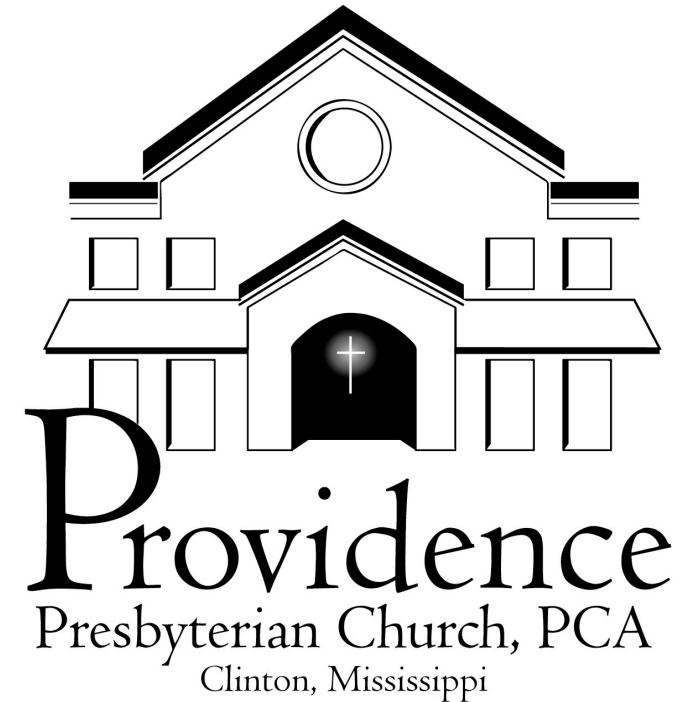
