The session has invited Don Clements (a Teaching Elder in the PCA) of Metokos Ministries (www.metokos.org) to come June 13–14. Don's ministry is designed to guide churches through the process of electing a Pulpit Committee to evaluate and recommend a pastor.

Heidelberg Catechism

We are looking at the Heidelberg Catechism together on Sunday nights in 2014. This catechism was written in 1563 and is the most widely used catechism from the Reformation. It is divided into 52 "Lord's Day" sections, structured after the Book of Romans and can be outlined with three words: Guilt (#3-11), Grace (#12-85) and Gratitude (#86-129).

Lord's Day 19

Q50. Why is it added, and sits at the right hand of God?

A. Christ ascended into heaven to manifest himself there as Head of his church, through whom the Father governs all things.

Q51. How does the glory of Christ, our Head, benefit us?

A. First, by his Holy Spirit he pours out heavenly gifts upon us, his members. Second, by his power he defends and preserves us against all enemies.

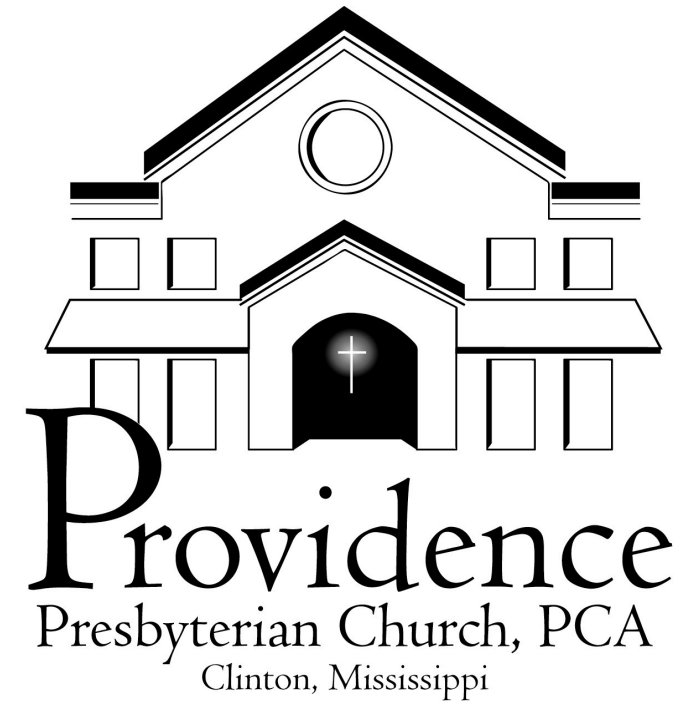
Q52. What comfort is it to you that Christ will come to judge the living and the dead?

A. In all my sorrow and persecution I lift up my head and eagerly await as judge from heaven the very same person who before has submitted himself to the judgment of God for my sake, and has removed all the curse from me. He will cast all his and my enemies into everlasting condemnation, but he will take me and all his chosen ones to himself into heavenly joy and glory.
