MARK YOUR CALENDARS – JULY 4th PICNIC!

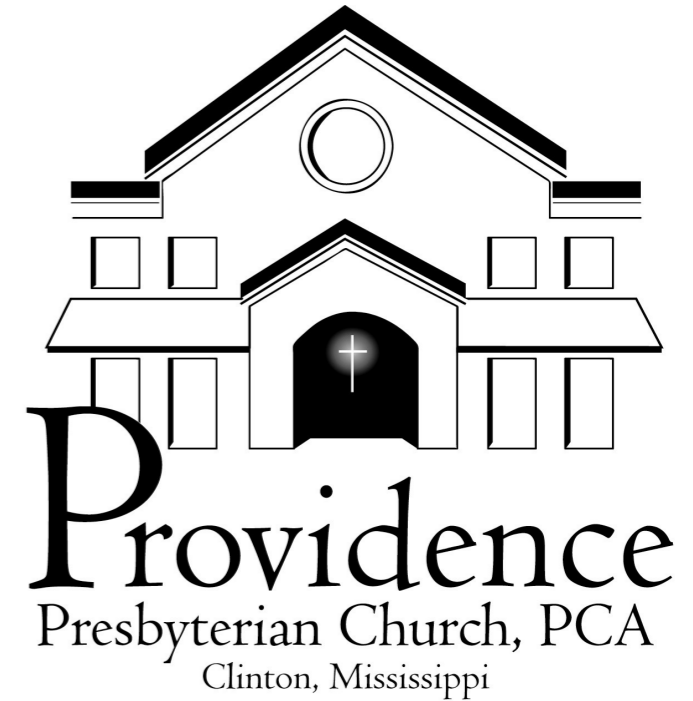
