HELP FLOOD VICTIMS

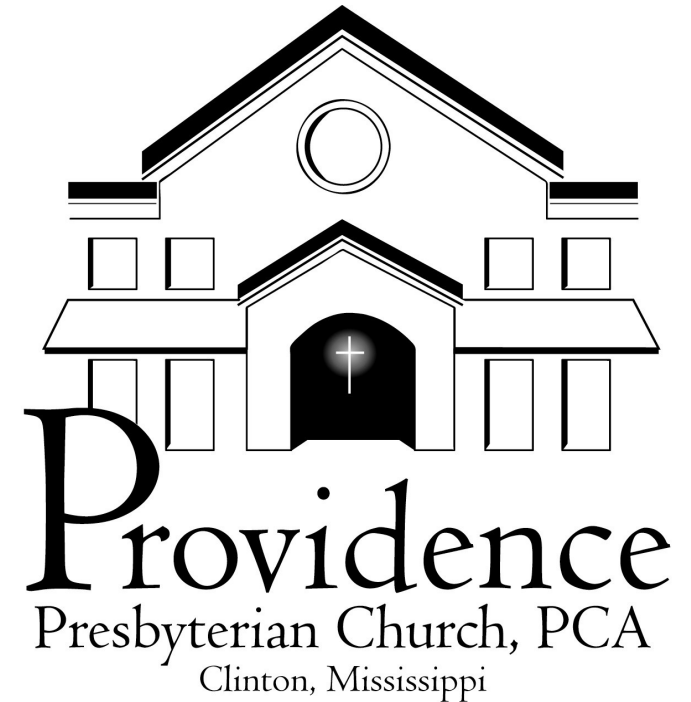
The Session has approved congregational donations for flood victims. You may make your check out to the church with “flood victims” and amount on the memo line or put a cash donation in the basket in the narthex.
