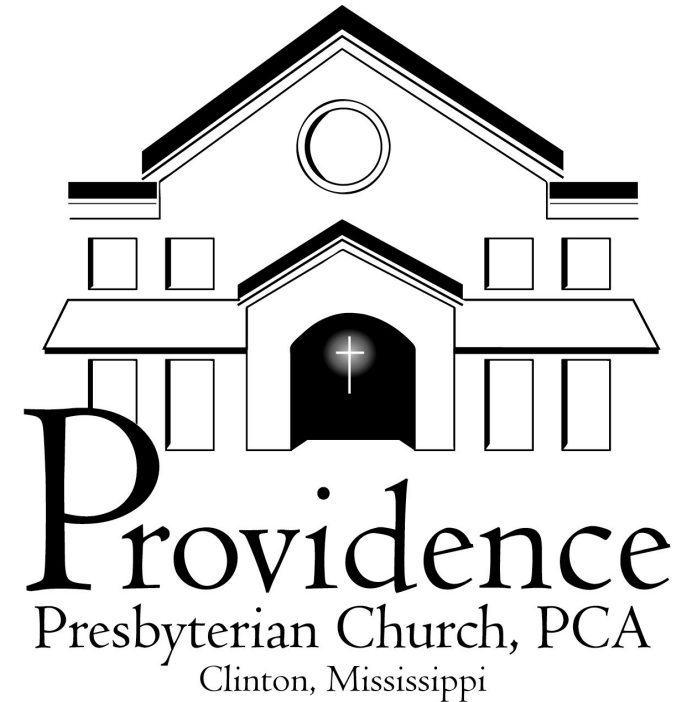
NEW MEMBERS
