Come rejoicing! Praise the everlasting King!

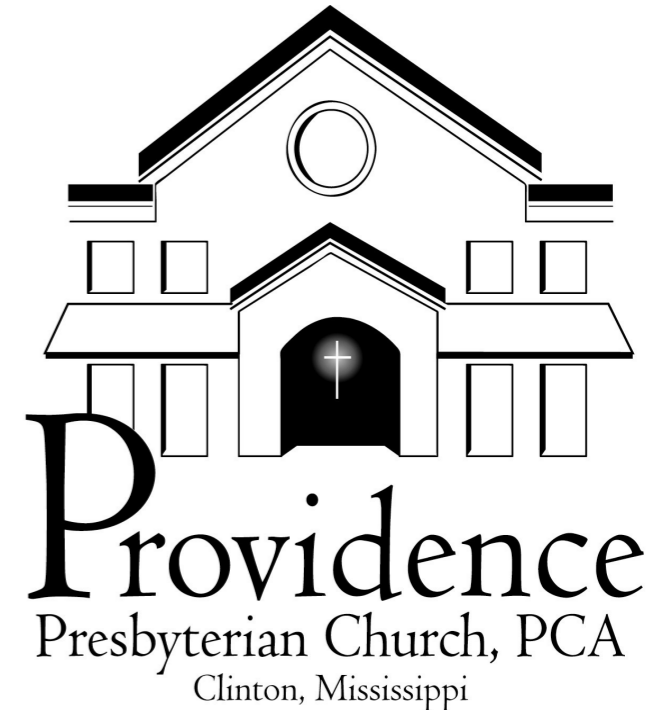
