Or walk the golden streets, or walk the golden streets.

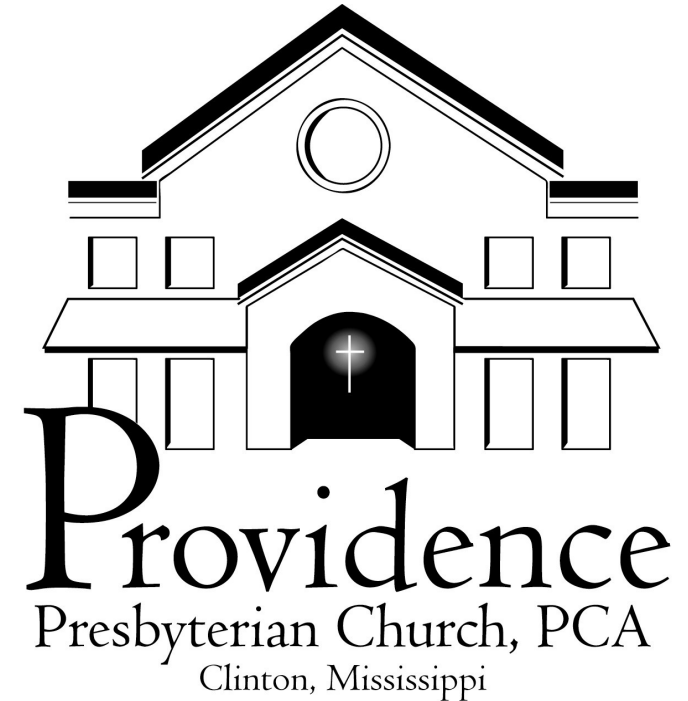
